Martha A. Lees is Deputy Superintendent and General Counsel of the New York State Insurance Department. As General Counsel, Lees advises the Superintendent and other officers of the Department regarding a wide array of legal matters and is responsible for supervision of the Office of General Counsel. In that capacity, she oversees the preparation of legal opinions, the promulgation of regulations, and the management of all litigation involving the Department.

In addition, Lees chairs the Multi-State Issues and Tax Subgroups of the Department's New York Insurance Exchange Working Group and is Counsel to the Superintendent's Insurance Filings Modernization Initiative.

Lees joined the Department after four years at the New York State Attorney General's office, where she served as Assistant Attorney General in the Litigation Bureau. In that



capacity, she represented the Department and various other state agencies in litigation brought against them, handling a variety of complex insurance and tax-related matters.

Prior to her service at the Attorney General's office, Lees spent several years as a full-time law professor, teaching business organizations and contracts at Rutgers University School of Law and Baruch College, City University of New York. She began her career as a commercial litigator at Cleary, Gottlieb, Steen & Hamilton, after serving as a law clerk to Judge R. Lanier Anderson of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit. She also clerked for Judge Nina Gershon of the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of New York.

Lees earned an A.B. in History and Literature from Harvard College and a J.D. from Harvard Law School. She lives in Brooklyn, New York with her husband and two children.
